Fine Arts Diploma Seal Requirements

The Fine Arts Diploma Seal will be awarded to graduating high school students (seniors) who:

- *Are graduating from South Cobb High School.*
- *Submit a transcript documenting the completion of a fine arts pathway (4 full credits) plus at least 1 additional fine arts credit or 1 credit in an approved Creative Industries CTAE course.*
- *Participate in 2 or more arts related extracurricular activities that foster fine arts mastery.*
- *Submit documentation of 20 hours of arts related community service to their high school.*
- *Complete a capstone presentation of their experiences at their high school on March 25, 2021.*

(This presentation should be evidence that demonstrates the development and presentation of a body of work such as an end of year show, a senior show, a website the presents your portfolio with an artist statement, etc. Documentation can be a video, a website, written paper, performance, live presentation, etc.)
